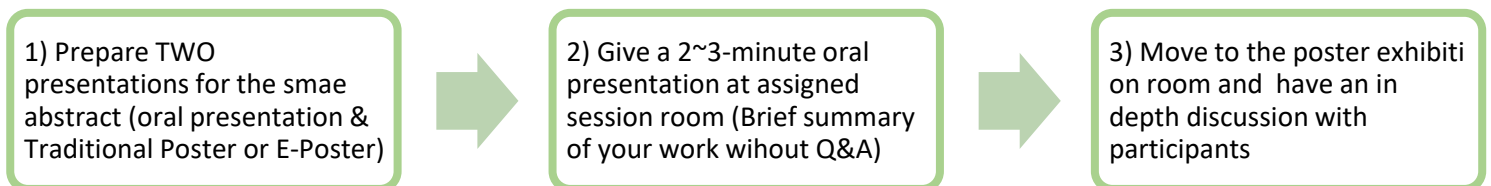


## POWER PITCH GUIDELINES

The power pitch session is designed to maximize the exposure and discussion of each abstract. This session consists of a 2~3-minute oral presentation followed by one hour of poster viewing.

Each speaker should create a **2~3-minute presentation (in English)** to highlight the essence of their work. We recommend organizing your presentation with a **maximum of five slides**. It is important that the speaker keep within the allocated 2~3-minute slot for the talk. The moderator will introduce the title and first author of the presentation and the presenter should start immediately after the introduction. **No questions** will be answered after the oral presentation.

After the oral presentations of all speakers, the speakers and audience will **move to the poster exhibition room** (Emerald Hall, 3F). The speakers are requested to be at their assigned places and are asked to present their presentations, allowing for the introduction of more details of the work and maximum interaction/discussion. These presentations will be done in a traditional poster format or electronic poster format. This year, free beer and soft drinks will be available during poster Q&A time for a more relaxed discussion and exchange of ideas.



### 1. Oral Presentation File

#### 1) Format

- Presentation slides should be made in MS-PPT or PPTX format (\*.ppt or \*.pptx) only.
- Version: 2007 higher version

**- Screen Ratio: 4:3**

- Page limit: maximum of five slides
