Mi-Na Kim is currently a professor of the Department of Laboratory Medicine at the University of Ulsan College of Medicine and Asan Medical Center in the South Korea. She received her Ph.D. in the medicine from the Seoul National University in South Korea. She was awarded an Aquamarine stripes Order of Service Merit by Korean Ministry of Health and Welfare in recognition of her lifetime service in the field of infection control in 2018 and the grand prize of Korean association of External Quality Assessment Service from achievement in nationwide quality control program of clinical microbiology in Korea in 2015. She also was awarded number of honors and scientific PRIZES; 11th Best Paper Award from The Korean Federation of Science and Technology Societies(2001), Abbott's Academic Award(2008), Best Paper Awards from Korean Society of Laboratory Medicine (2010, 2012). She is a former chairperson of laboratory response task force on MERS-CoV outbreak, former chairperson of external quality control program of clinical microbiology, former president of Korean healthcare-associated infection control and prevention, former chairperson of infection control committee in Korean Society of Laboratory Medicine and current executive committee member of Asian Pacific Society of Infection Control and Prevention. Her research interests have focused on studies of the clinical microbiology and hospital epidemiology. More recently She concentrated on the method evaluation and quality control of molecular diagnosis of MERS-CoV and molecular mechanism of resistance and epidemiology, and infection control of multidrug-resistance organisms.
