Dr. Parul Bhargava is currently a Professor of Laboratory Medicine at the University of California, San Francisco in the United States of America. She attended medical school at the Lady Hardinge Medical College, University of Delhi, India, residency in Anatomic and Clinical Pathology at Georgetown University Medical center, Washington DC, USA followed by a fellowship in hematopathology at Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center and Harvard Medical School in Boston Massachusetts. She was the director of the hematology, coagulation and flow cytometry laboratories at Beth Israel Deaconess Medical center for 16 years, and since 2017 is the medical director of Clinical laboratories at UCSF. She is a member of the College of American Pathologists hematology resource committee, and has been on the board or scientific committees of several hematology organizations including United States and Canadian Academy of Pathologists, American Society of Hematology, Society for hematopathology and International society of laboratory hematology. She has received several teaching awards, taught short courses, and authored many books and book chapters. Her research interests have focused on pathogenesis of hematologic malignancies, and on laboratory testing in hematology and coagulation.
