

# Poster Presentation Guidelines

※ All presenters are required to attend and present onsite. ※

Please note the following information for poster preparation by the assigned session.

## 1. Overview of Poster Presentation

\* All presenters are required to affix and remove their posters at the following times.

\* The Poster Presentation Session will be held over two days, and each abstract is assigned a different schedule to attend. Kindly refer to the email for your assigned schedule.

- **Poster Presentation Session 1: Mar. 19 (Thu.) 16:00-16:40 / Grand Round (B1F)**

- **Poster Presentation Session 2: Mar. 20 (Fri.) 15:50-16:30 / Grand Round (B1F)**

## 2. Poster Size

● Poster panels are 95cm in width by 237cm in height.

● Poster size should be **A0 (841mmx1189mm)** including the title page.

Alternatively, presenters may prepare their posters using multiple A4 sheets if preferred.

## 3. Regulations and Information

● **All presenters should prepare and print their own poster.** The secretariat does not provide printing service.

● **All poster presenters are required to stand in front of their poster panels and present their presentation at the designated (allocated) time.**

Allocated presentation time will be informed to each presenter with email.

● Please refer to your allocated poster code in your poster presentation guidelines (Poster Code will be informed to each presenter with E-mail.)

● Posters should be legible by viewers from one meter away. **The poster title, author(s) name(s) and affiliation(s) should** appear at the top. The message should be clear and understandable without an oral explanation.

● Posters should show the main content or main results of the paper.

● Only adhesive tape will be available to attach your poster to the panel (Tape will be provided in the poster session area).

● All presenters should remove their posters at removal time. If not, posters will be removed by staff without notice and the organizing committee will not take any responsibility for any lost or damaged posters.
